Dr. Riaz is an Assistant Clinical Professor of Medicine and Assistant Clinical Professor of Orthopedic Surgery at the University of Arizona, Department of Medicine, Division of Infectious Diseases. Born in Pakistan, he developed an interest in infectious diseases during a research fellowship in cardiovascular infectious diseases. Under the mentorship of Dr. Camelia Marculescu, he cultivated a strong interest in musculoskeletal infections and later advanced his expertise in orthopedic infectious diseases while training under Dr. Doug Osmon. He has contributed to multiple research projects on osteoarticular infections, including a multicenter study on risk factors for fungal prosthetic joint infections. After completing his fellowship, he joined the Cleveland Clinic Health System and served on staff at Northeast Ohio Medical University. In addition to his research, Dr. Riaz manages patients with cardiovascular infections, including infective endocarditis and cardiovascular device-related infections. He is also dedicated to teaching and mentoring medical students and residents.
