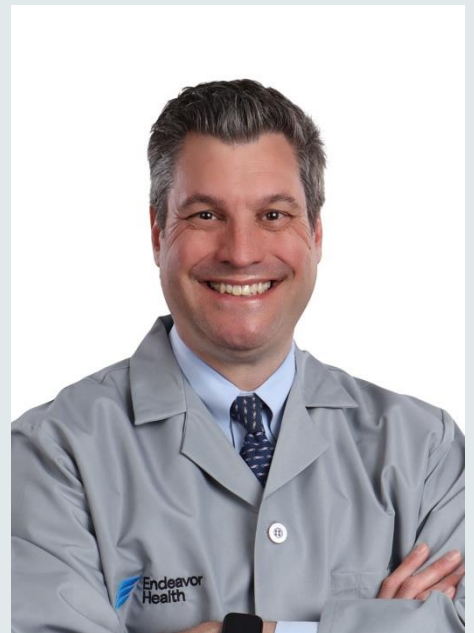

Implementing and Scaling Personalized Medicine

Dr. Hulick is the Janardan D. Khandekar, MD, Chair of Personalized Medicine and Division Head for Medical Genetics at Endeavor Health (previously NorthShore), which applies genetic analysis to prevention, diagnosis and treatment of inherited diseases and disorders. He joined Endeavor Health as an attending physician in medical genetics in 2008, became Division Head of Medical Genetics in 2012 and Medical Director for the Mark R. Neaman Center for Personalized Medicine prior to his chair appointment in 2022. Dr. Hulick also serves as a Clinical Associate Professor in the Department of Human Genetics at the University of Chicago Pritzker School of Medicine. Previously, he served as an attending physician in medical genetics at Massachusetts General Hospital in Boston, Massachusetts. He is the current Chair-Elect for the American Board of Medical Genetics and Genomics (ABMGG). He has authored or co-authored more than 70 peer reviewed journal articles and book chapters.

Dr. Hulick earned his medical degree from Jefferson Medical College in 2001. He completed a residency in internal medicine at St. Luke's Hospital – Mayo Clinic and completed a clinical fellowship in medical genetics at Harvard Medical School. He also earned a master's degree in medical science from Harvard Medical School in 2007.
